JESSIE VINEYARD

Jessie Vineyard, first established in 1994, was named for founder Paul Gerrie's paternal grandmother, Jessie Sommers Gerrie. Perhaps the most challenging vineyard to farm on the Cristom estate, these 11.5 acres of dramatically steep, densely planted Pinot Noir situated on the mid-slope of our east-facing hillside produce some of the most seductive and complex wines we craft.

EILEEN VINEYARD

Perched at the crest of the Eola Hills (735 ft) on the Cristom estate, Eileen Vineyard, named after co-founder Eileen Gerrie, is defined by both the cold, Pacific Ocean winds that blast the site via the Van Duzer Corridor and by the dramatic volcanic soil variation from ancient basalt flows. First established in 1997, Eileen Vineyard has grown to nearly 22 acres of Pinot Noir. The fruit is structured, vibrant, and persistent.

LOUISE VINEYARD

Established in 1993, Louise Vineyard is named after Winegrower and Owner Tom Gerrie's great-grandmother. Louise is planted on the lowest slopes of the estate and is more sheltered from the cold Pacific Ocean winds by a small forest and hillside. 12.3 acres of Pinot Noir are predominantly planted over a range of volcanic soils and the resulting wines have softened, focused acidity, and intense complexity, with a richness contributed by the 26–30-year-old vines.

MARJORIE VINEYARD

First established in 1982, the Gerries re-named the existing vineyard after Paul's mother when they purchased the estate in 1992. Marjorie is the oldest vineyard on the estate. Though mostly replanted, the 8.4 acres of Pinot Noir on a gently sloping bench of moderately deep volcanic soil in the heart of the hillside produce small, highly concentrated clusters. The resulting wines are concentrated and graceful with a distinct texture and elegance.

PAUL GERRIE VINEYARD

Named for Cristom's founder, Paul Gerrie Vineyard is a consistent, gently sloping bench of deep volcanic soil. Rising from 540 ft. to nearly 800 ft., it is our largest vineyard with 22 acres of Pinot Noir. In development since 2014, it is the cornerstone of Cristom's future. The site combines some of the greatest aspects of the estate – soils, wind, elevation, and slope – into a single vineyard and represents the culmination of farming knowledge gained over three decades.
