**VINEYARD:** Established in 1973 on a south-facing slope over deep volcanic soils in the Dundee Hills, Durant Vineyard is a historic, pioneering site in Oregon viticulture.

**AVA:** Sheltered from the Pacific Ocean breeze by its position between the Coast Range and the Chehalem Mountains, the Dundee Hills AVA is defined by ancient, deep volcanic Jory soils known for excellent drainage and their oxidized red coloring—famously known as the “red hills of Dundee.”

**VINEYARD:** Sustainably farmed and surrounded by a forest reserve, this Eola-Amity Hills vineyard has moderate elevation, Nekia and Jory volcanic soils, varied aspects, and a mix of Dijon and Pommard clones.

**AVA:** The Eola-Amity Hills AVA straddles the 45th parallel, has a diverse range of volcanic soils, and is heavily influenced by the cool Pacific Ocean winds through a gap in the Coast Range.

**VINEYARD:** This pioneering site was established in 1988 with own-rooted vines over rocky volcanic soils.

**AVA:** Vines in the McMinnville AVA are planted in some of Oregon's oldest and most geologically complex soils. The Pacific Ocean's influence provides a cool and dry microclimate.
